## Our giving is an act of Worship

It is an expression of our gratitude for God's love and all that He has given us.

God is the ultimate owner of all we have. He calls us to be generous with what he gives us: money, time and talents.

# How can I give financially?

You can give to the mission and ministry of the church by joining the '**Parish Giving Scheme**' (PGS).

Many of our church members have joined this excellent monthly giving scheme, as it helps our treasurers plan the budget for the year ahead.

If you are eligible to claim **Gift Aid** on your giving, PGS will also claim this back from the HMRC and pay it to the church each month.

## How much should I give?

We are called to love God and love our neighbour generously and sacrificially. Our financial giving is an expression of that love.

Many Christians find the Biblical principle of the tithe (10%) a helpful place to start. This was an Old Testament principle that seems to have continued into the life of the New Testament church.

However, the early church approached giving as a grace filled response to God's love, rather than a legal command. Therefore, how much to give is a thoughtful, prayerful decision that only you can make.

Love is generous, love is kind and love is selfless – we see that in all that God gives to us. How will we respond?
